
Samuel BARNES (c. 1791-c. 1877)

1. **Samuel BARNES**, son of John BARNES (-) and Mary SCOTT (-), was born c. 1791 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen, Norfolk - 50, farmer, living with wife Mary (50), Mother Mary (86) and servant Maria MILES (19). He was baptised on 4 Sep 1791 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen. He married **Mary SHEPPERSON** on 1 Jun 1822 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - married by licence. The marriage was witnessed by Francis RICHARDS and Thomas SHEPPERSON. The ceremony was conducted by Rev. Charles BOUTRELL, curate. He appeared in the census in 1841 at The Street in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - 50, farmer, living with wife Mary (50), Mother Mary (86) and servant Maria MILES (19). In 1846 the Electoral Register showed him living at Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - copyhold house and land in Pulham Street. Samuel appeared in the census in 1851 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - 59, farmer of 92 acres employing 5 labourers and 1 boy, living with wife Mary (60) and Ann BROWN (23, house servant). In 1856 the Electoral Register showed him living at Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - copyhold house and land in Pulham Street. Samuel appeared in the census in 1861 at The Street in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - 70, farmer of 112 acres employing 5 labourers and 1 boy, living with wife Mary (69) and Emma ARMES (20, house servant). In 1866 the Electoral Register showed him living at Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - copyhold house and land in Pulham Street. Samuel appeared in the census in 1871 at The Street in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - 78, farmer of 112 acres employing 5 men, living with wife Mary (77). In 1873 he was living in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen and owned land in Norfolk - area: 114A 1R 26P (43.61 hectares); rentable value: £11 17s. In 1876 the Electoral Register showed him living at Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - copyhold house and land in Pulham Street. Samuel died c. 1877 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen. He was buried on 19 Jul 1877 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen - age 85 years. He had his estate probated on 19 Jun 1879 in Norwich, Norfolk - "BARNES Samuel. 19 June [1879]. The Will of Samuel Barnes late of Pulham St. Mary Magdalen in the County of Norfolk Yeoman who died 12 July 1877 at Pulham St. Mary Magdalen was proved at Norwich by John Matthew Barnes of Morningthorpe in the said County Farmer the Son the sole Executor. Personal Estate under £20".

Mary SHEPPERSON, daughter of Samuel SHEPPERSON (-) and Elizabeth UNKNOWN (-), was born c. 1788 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen. She was baptised on 4 Jan 1789 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen. She and Samuel BARNES had the following children:
