Rachel BECKETT (1821-1896)

Rachel BECKETT, daughter of James BECKETT (c. 1773-1849) and Mary BARNARD (c. 1781-1845), was born on 2 Jul 1821 in Tharston. She was baptised on 8 Jul 1821 in Tharston. She appeared in the census in 1841 in Tharston - 15, living in the household of Elizabeth RIX (60). She appeared in the census in 1851 in Tharston - 27, living with brother James (37, farmer of 48 acres employing 3 labourers). She appeared in the census in 1861 at The Street in Needham, Norfolk - 30, housekeeper, living in the household of Samuel TAYLOR (67, farmer of 33 acres employing 1 man). She appeared in the census in 1871 at By the Common in Wacton, Norfolk - 44, farmer of 200 acres, living with visitor Ann J HARRISON (34) and servants Caroline GIRLING (25, general servant), Louisa LIGHTNING (17, general servant) and William NICHOLS (15, farm servant). In the 1873 England and Wales Return of Owners of Land she owned land in Norfolk - she was living in Tharston and owned land area A.3 P.1 R.6 (1.33 Hectares), rentable value £11. She appeared in the census in 1881 in Tharston - 54, farmer of 45 acres employing 2 men, living with servant Sarah SMITH (14, general servant). She appeared in the census in 1891 at The Street in Tharston - 65, farmer, living with servant Amelia ROBERTS (15, domestic servant). She died on 21 Jan 1896 in Tharston. She was buried on 27 Jan 1896 in Tharston. She is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard Tharston- "IN MEMORY OF • RACHEL BECKETT • WHO DEPARTED THIS LIFE • JAN. 21ST 1896 • AGED 74 YEARS • THE LORD GAVE AND THE LORD HATH TAKEN AWAY. BLESSED BE THE NAME OF THE LORD". She had her estate probated on 1 Jan 1897 in London - "BECKETT Rachel of Tharston Norfolk spinster died 21 January 1896 Probate London 1 January to Alfred John Browne Kett and John Barnard farmers. Effects £596 Os. 11d.".

- 2. **James BECKETT**, son of James BECKETT and Elizabeth WATSON, was born c. 1773 in Tharston. He was baptised on 23 May 1773 in Tharston. He and Mary BARNARD had marriage banns published on 9 Sep 1804 in Tharston other dates were 16.09.1804 and 23.09.1804. He married her on 8 Oct 1804 in Bunwell witnesses were Elizabeth BARNARD and Thomas OAKLEY. He appeared in the census in 1841 in Tharston 65, farmer, living with wife Mary (60), children Sarah (25, female servant) and James (25, male servant), and John BECKETT (60, agricultural labourer). He died on 21 Mar 1849 in Tharston. He was buried on 28 Mar 1849 in Tharston. He is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard Tharston- "IN MEMORY OF MARY THE WIFE OF JAMES BECKETT WHO DIED FEB 1ST 1845 AGED 65 YEARS [THREE LINES ILLEGIBLE] ALSO OF JAMES BECKETT HER AFFECTIONATE HUSBAND WHO DIED MARCH 21ST 1849 AGED 75 YEARS [FIVE LINES ILLEGIBLE]".
- 3. Mary BARNARD was born c. 1781. She appeared in the census in 1841 in Tharston 609, living with husband James (65, farmer), children Sarah (25, female servant) and James (25, male servant), and John BECKETT (60, agricultural labourer). She died on 1 Feb 1845 in Tharston. She was buried on 6 Feb 1845 in Tharston. She is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard Tharston- "IN MEMORY OF MARY THE WIFE OF JAMES BECKETT WHO DIED FEB 1ST 1845 AGED 65 YEARS [THREE LINES ILLEGIBLE] ALSO OF JAMES BECKETT HER AFFECTIONATE HUSBAND WHO DIED MARCH 21ST 1849 AGED 75 YEARS [FIVE LINES ILLEGIBLE]". She and James BECKETT had the following children:
 - Sarah BECKETT (-1891). Sarah appeared in the census in 1841 in Tharston 25, female servant, living with parents James (65, farmer) and Mary (60), brother James (25, male servant), and John BECKETT (60, agricultural labourer). She died on 23 Aug 1891 in Metfield, Suffolk. She was buried on 2 Sep 1891 in Tharston living in Metfield, Suffolk at the time of her death. She is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard Tharston- "IN AFFECTIONATE REMEMBRANCE OF SARAH BECKETT DAUGHTER OF THE LATE JAMES & MARY BECKETT BORN FEB. 7TH 1870 [?] DIED AUG. 23RD 1891".
 - James BECKETT (1813-1870). James was born on 13 Jul 1813 in Tharston. He was baptised on 8 Aug 1813 in Tharston. He appeared in the census in 1841 in Tharston 25, male servant, living with parents James (65, farmer) and Mary (60), sister Sarah (25, female servant), and John BECKETT (60, agricultural labourer). He appeared in the census in 1851 in Tharston 37, farmer of 48 acres employing 3 labourers, living with sister Rachel (27). He married Sarah STANLEY on 28 Sep 1852 in Pulham St. Mary Magdalen witnesses were Rachel BECKETT and George EVERETT. He appeared in the census in 1861 at Wacton Hall Farm, Moulton in Moulton 47, farmer of 233 acres employing 6 men, living with wife Sarah (47) and servants Harriet GIRLING (18, dairy maid), Ann MEARS (16, housemaid), William MEARS (22, carter), Walter LONG (15, cowboy) and George DADE (14, cowboy). He died on 27 Dec 1870 in Tharston. He was buried on 4 Jan 1871 in Tharston. He is commorated in St. Mary's Churchyard Tharston- "JAMES BECKETT FORMERLY OF THIS PARISH LATE OF WACTON HALL WHO DIED ON THE 27TH DAY OF DECEMBER 1870 IN THE 51ST [thought it should have read in his 57th year] YEAR OF HIS AGE SARAH / THE WIFE OF JAMES BECKETT OF WACTON HALL WHO DIED ON THE 17TH DAY OF AUGUST 1861 IN THE 49TH YEAR OF HER

He died c. 1853 in Tharston. He was buried on 26 May 1853 in Tharston.
