Charles BISHOP (1816-1880)

Charles BISHOP, son of John BISHOP (c. 1773-c. 1851) and Rebecca Blomfield DAY (c. 1785-), was born on 14 Oct 1816 in Diss, Norfolk. He appeared in the census in 1841 at Cock Street Green in Diss - 25, carpenter, living with parents John (60, carter) and Rebecca (56), and siblings Sarah (27) and William (17). He married Harriet HOWLETT c. 1841 - reg: Depwade Norfolk. He appeared in the census in 1851 at Cock Street in Diss - 34, carpenter journyman, living with wife Harriet (33) and children Henry (4, scholar), Emily (2) and Louisa (3 mos). He appeared in the census in 1861 at Cock Street in Diss - 43, master carpenter employing 3 men, living with wife Harriet (42) and children Henry (14, scholar), Emily (12, scholar) and Louisa (10, scholar). In 1865 the Electoral Register showed him living at - freehold land; Roydon Road, Diss. Charles appeared in the census in 1871 at Denmark Street in Diss - widower, 53, builder and contractor employing 28 men 6 apprentices 3 boys, living with son Henry George (24) and daughters Emily (22) and Louisa (20). In the 1873 England and Wales Return of Owners of Land he owned land in Norfolk - Diss; area: 12A 20R (4.91 hectares); rentable value: £63 5s. On 15 Mar 1873 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk Chronicle:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the Partnership heretofore subsisting between us, the undersigned, CHARLES BISHOP and HENRY GEORGE BISHOP, lately carrying on business under the named firm of "Charles Bishop and Son," at Diss in the County of Norfolk, as Builders, was dissolved on the 6th of January, 1873, by mutual consent; and that the business will in future will be carried on by the said HENRY GEORGE BISHOP, under the same style or firm in his own account. Dated this 12th day of March, 1873,

In 1875 the Electoral Register showed him living at - freehold land; Roydon Road, Diss. In 1880 the Electoral Register showed him living at - freehold land; Roydon Road, Diss. Charles died on 10 Apr 1880 in Diss. He was buried on 17 Apr 1880 in Diss, the ceremony was conducted by Rev. C. R. MANNING. He had his estate probated on 31 Aug 1880 in Norwich, Norfolk - "BISHOP Charles. 11 August [1880]. The Will with three Codicils of Charles Bishop late of Diss in the County of Norfolk Gentleman who died 10 April 1880 at Diss was proved at Norwich by Henry Edwin Garrod Solicitor and William Bishop Ironmonger the Brother both of Diss the Executors. Personal Estate under £300.". On 11 Feb 1881 there was a newspaper report in the Diss Express:

CHARLES BISHOP, DECEASED.

Persuant to the Statute 22 and 23 Victoria, chapter 35, entitled, "An Act to further amend the Law of Property and to relieve Trustees,"

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that all Creditors and persons having any claims or demands upon or against the Estate of CHARLES BISHOP, late of Diss, in the County of Norfolk, retired Builder, Deceased, (who died on the 10th day of April, 1880, and whose Will (with three Codicils) was proved by Henry Edwin Garrod, of Diss, aforesaid, Solicitor, and William Bishop, of the same place, Ironmonger, the Executors therein named, on the 11th day of August, 1880, in the Norwich District Registry in the Probate Division of the High Court of Justice) are hereby required to send in writing the Particulars of their claims and demands to the undersigned on or before the 31st day of March, 1881, after which date the Executors will distribute the Assets of the said Deceased, having regard
