
James CORBLE (c. 1788-1874)

1. **James CORBLE**, son of Joseph CORBLE (-) and Elizabeth BALDRY (-), was born c. 1788 in Blo Norton, Norfolk. He was baptised on 19 Oct 1788 in Blo Norton - public baptism. He married **Sarah PEACHEY** on 26 Dec 1815 in Blo Norton. The marriage was witnessed by Elizabeth PEACHEY and Elizabeth HUBBARD. He appeared in the census in 1841 at Fen Common in South Lopham, Norfolk - 50, living with wife Sarah (50), daughter Sarah (20, dressmaker) and son John (16). In 1849 the Electoral Register showed him living at South Lopham - owning a freehold house and land in Blo Norton occupied by Nathan Corble. James appeared in the census in 1851 at Low Common in South Lopham - 62, farmer of 15 acres employing 1 man, living with wife Sarah (61). In 1856 the Electoral Register showed him living at South Lopham - owning a freehold house and land in Blo Norton occupied by Nathan Corble tenant. James appeared in the census in 1861 at St. Stephen's Plain in Norwich, Norfolk - widower, 72, retired farmer, living in the household of his daughter and son-in-law Cooper BROOKS (47, currier and leather merchant) and Sarah BROOKS (40). In 1866 the Electoral Register showed him living at St. Stephen's, Norwich - owning a freehold house and land in Blo Norton occupied by Thomas Sturgeon. James married **Elizabeth GARNHAM** on 6 Aug 1867 in South Lopham. He appeared in the census in 1871 at Workhouse Common in South Lopham - 82, house owner, living with wife Elizabeth (82). In 1874 the Electoral Register showed him living at St. Stephen's, Norwich - owning a freehold house and land in Blo Norton occupied by Thomas Sturgeon. James died on 31 Dec 1874 in South Lopham. He was buried on 5 Jan 1875 in Blo Norton, the ceremony was conducted by Rev. J. THOMPSON - aged 86 years, from South Lopham. He had his estate probated on 7 May 1875 in Norwich - "CORBLE James. 7 May [1875]. The Will of James Corble late of South Lopham in the County of Norfolk Yeoman who died 31 December 1874 at South Lopham was proved at Norwich by George Bowell of Blo Norton in the said County Farmer the Nephew one of the Executors. Effects under £100.".

Sarah PEACHEY was born c. 1789. She died c. 1858. She and James CORBLE had the following children:
