Malteyward CROWE (1813-1894)

Malteyward CROWE, son of Thomas CROWE (c. 1778-c. 1852) and Susanna THURLOW (c. 1784-c. 1. 1847), was born on 14 Apr 1813 in Wetheringsett, Suffolk. He was baptised on 1 Aug 1813 in Wetheringsett; parents Thomas and Susanna (nee THORLOW). He married Mary COATES c. 1838 (reg: Bosmere Suffolk).² He appeared in the in 1841 census at Fen Common in South Lopham, Norfolk: 28, living with wife Mary (23) and children Robert (2) and Malteyward (5 mos).3 He appeared in the in 1851 census at High Common in South Lopham: 37, farmer of 35 acres employing 1 man and 2 boys, living with wife Mary (32) and children Robert Coates (11, working on farm), Malteyward (10, scholar), Edgar (7, scholar), Mary Coates (5, scholar) and Thomas Peck (9 mos). He appeared in the in 1861 census at Barkers Farm Low Common in South Lopham: 47, farmer 154 acres employs 4 men 4 boys, living with wife Mary (43) and children Robert Coates (21, agricultural labourer), Malteyward (20, agricultural labourer), Edgar (17, agricultural labourer), Mary Coates (15, scholar), Thomas Park (5, scholar), Hephzibah (3) and George Sheldrake (1). He appeared in the in 1871 census at Barkers Farm in South Lopham: 57, farmer of 179 acres employing 7 men ans 2 boys, living with wife Mary (54) and children Mildeyward (30, shepherd), Thomas P (14, scholar), Hephzibah (12, scholar) and George S (11, scholar). He appeared in the in 1881 census at The Street in Blo Norton, Norfolk: 67, farmer of 112 acres employing 4 men and 1 boy, living with wife Mary (62), son George (21, farmer's son), and servants Thomas GOOCH (20, farm servant), Arthur HUGGINS (14, farm servant) and Hagar LUDBROOK (14, general servant). He appeared in the in 1891 census at Church Farm The Street in North Lopham, Norfolk: 77, farmer, living with wife Mary (72).8 He died on 2 Nov 1894 in North Lopham, reg: Guiltcross Norfolk. 9,10 He was buried on 7 Nov 1894 in South Lopham. There is a memorial in St. Andrew Churchyard in Wetheringsett - "In Memory of / MALTEYWARD CROWE. / WHO DIED NOVr 2nd 894. / AGED 81 YEARS. / ALSO MARY. / BELVED WIFE OF THE ABOVE. / WHO DIED DECr 24th 1894. / AGED 76 YEARS. / So shall we abide in union. / With each other and the Lord. / And possess in sweet communion. / Joys which earth cannot afford.". His estate probate was granted on 8 Mar 1895 in Norwich, Norfolk: CROWE Malteyward of North Lopham Norfolk farmer died 2 November 1894 Administration (with Will) Norwich 8 March to Edgar Crowe farmer. Effects £255 1s. 3d.¹⁰

Mary COATES, daughter of Robert COATES (c. 1783-c. 1852) and Mary KEEBLE (c. 1783-), was born c. 1818 in Crowfield, Suffolk. She died c. 1894. She and Malteyward CROWE had the following children:

in the in 1841 census at Fen Common in South Lopham, Norfolk: 5 mos, living with parents Malteyward (28) and Mary (23), and brother Robert (2).3 He appeared in the in 1851 census at High Common in South Lopham: 10, scholar, living with parents Mildeyward (37, farmer of 35 acres employing 1 man and 2 boys) and Mary (32), and children Robert Coates (11, working on farm), Edgar (7, scholar), Mary Coates (5, scholar) and Thomas Peck (9 mos).4 He appeared in the in 1861 census at Barkers Farm Low Common in South Lopham: 20, agricultural labourer, living with parents Mildeyward (47, farmer of 154 acres employs 4 men 4 boys) and Mary (43) and siblings Robert Coates (21, agricultural labourer), Edgar (17, agricultural labourer), Mary Coates (15, scholar), Thomas Park (5, scholar); Hephzibah (3) and George Sheldrake (1).5 He appeared in the in 1871 census at Barkers Farm in South Lopham: 30, shepherd, living with parents Mildeyward (57, farmer of 179 acres employing 7 men ans 2 boys) and Mary (54), and siblings Thomas P (14, scholar), Hephzibah (12, scholar) and George S (11, scholar).6 He and Elizabeth ABBOTT had marriage banns published on 8 Jan 1871 in South Lopham.11 other dates were 15.01.1871 and 22.01.1871. Malteyward married Elizabeth ABBOTT on 22 Jan 1871 in South Lopham.12 He died c. 1879.

- 4. **Edgar CROWE**, son of Malteyward CROWE and Mary COATES, was born c. 1844. He died c. 1930.
- 5. **Mary Coates CROWE**, daughter of Malteyward CROWE and Mary COATES, was born c. 1846. She died c. 1930.
