Robert EACOCK (c. 1812-1888)

1. Robert EACOCK, son of Warren EACOCK (c. 1772-c. 1832) and Sarah FROST (c. 1773-c. 1816), was born c. 1812 in Wyverstone, Suffolk. He was baptised on 26 Dec 1813 in Wyverstone - parents Warren and Sarah. He appeared in the census in 1841 at The Street in Hopton, Suffolk - 30, veterinary surgeon, living with Stephen JACQUES (20, gardener). He married Mary Ann BROOKS on 7 Jun 1842 in Redgrave, Suffolk - reg: Hartismere Suffolk. He appeared in the census in 1851 at Vine Inn in Hopton - 40, veterinary surgeon, living with wife Mary Ann (36) and children Sarah (12), Brooke Robert (7), William B (6), Thomas W (4), Joseph M (3) and Mary Ann (1). He appeared in the census in 1861 at TheInetham Road in Hopton - 50, veterinary surgeon, living with wife Mary Ann (46), children Brooke R (17, apprentice plumber and glazier), William F (15, veterinary surgeon), Thomas W (14, scholar), John M (13, scholar), Mary A (11, scholar), Joseph (9, scholar), George James (8, scholar) and Frank (4, scholar), and house servant Charlotte Savoye (15). He appeared in the census in 1871 at High Common in South Lopham, Norfolk - 58, veterinary surgeon and farmer of 150 acres employing 2 men and 1 boy, living with wife Mary Ann (55, veterinary surgeon) and children William F (26, veterinary surgeon), Mary Ann (21) and Frank (14, scholar). On 13 Mar 1874 there was a newspaper report in the The Diss Express, and Norfolk and Suffolk Journal:

MARRIED

SCRUTTON - EACOCK. - On the 12th inst., at South Lopham, by the Rev. Saw, Arthur Edgar, only son of Edgar Scrutton, farmer, Brandeston, Suffolk, to Mary Anne, youngest daughter of Robert Eacock, farmer, South Lopham, Norfolk.

In 1875 the Electoral Register showed him living in South Lopham - he was a £12 rated occupier of a house and land on High Common. On 26 Jun 1880 there was a newspaper report in the The Downham Market Gazette and People's Weekley Journal:

EAST HARLING.

Robert Eacock, of South Lopham, farmer, for allowing a mare to stray on the highway, at South Lopham, was fined, with costs, 6s.5d.

On 3 Sep 1880 there was a newspaper report in the The Diss Express, and Norfolk and Suffolk Journal:

TO LET, with possession at Michaelmas next, "MILL POND FARM," South Lopham, now in the occupation of Robert Eacock, who intends giving up farming. - For particulars apply to R. Eacock, Mill Pond Farm, South Lopham.

Robert appeared in the census in 1881 at The Street in Hopton - 70, veterinarian, living with wife Mary Ann (66) and grandson Arthur E SCRUTTON (5, carpenter's son visitor). In 1888 the Electoral Register showed him living in Hopton - he owned a freehold house and land on Garboldisham Road in South Lopham. Robert died on 24 Jul 1888 in Hopton. On 10 Aug 1888 there was a newspaper report in the The Diss Express, and Norfolk and Suffolk Journal:
