
Robert FEAVIOUR (1830-1887)

1. **Robert FEAVIOUR**, son of Robert FEAVIOUR (c. 1792-c. 1850) and Harriet BUCKINGHAM (c. 1793-c. 1852), was born on 20 Jun 1830 in Harleston, Norfolk. He was baptised on 25 Aug 1830 in Redenhall, Norfolk - father a publican (possibly the Garden House). He appeared in the census in 1841 in Redenhall - 11, living with parents Robert (50, greengrocer) and Harriet (50), and sister Harriet (15, straw hat maker). He appeared in the census in 1851 at The Thoroughfare in Harleston - 20, assistant, living with mother Harriet (widow, 61, shopkeeper) and niece Harriet BETTS (4). He married **Mary BORRETT** c. 1854 - reg: Hoxne Suffolk. On 15 Jun 1857 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk News:

TO COACH MAKERS. - Wanted Immediately, a Man in the Wood line. Good wages and constant work. - Apply to Robert Feaviour, Fressingfield, Suffolk.

Robert appeared in the census in 1861 at Queens Head Street in Stradbroke, Suffolk - 31, coach builder, living with wife Mary (33, dressmaker) and children Mary Ellen (5), Harriett (3) and Robert (1). He appeared in the census in 1871 at Nine Cross Way in Fressingfield, Suffolk - 41, gig builder and grocer, living with wife Mary (43) and children Mary Ellen (15), Robert Lindsay (12, scholar), Frederick George (8, scholar) and Arthur (6, scholar). In the 1873 England and Wales Return of Owners of Land he owned land in Norfolk - living in Fressingfield, Suffolk; land area A.1 R.0 P.1 (0.41 hectares); rentable value £7. He married **Emma WHITNEY** on 26 Mar 1874 in Stradbroke. On 4 Apr 1874 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk News:

MARRIAGES.

FEAVIOUR - WHITNEY - March 26, at the Baptist Chaple, Stradbroke, by the Rev. Mr. Cobb, Mr. Robert Feaviour of Fressingfield, to Miss Emma Whitney of Rotherie, London.

On 15 Aug 1874 there was a newspaper report in the Norfolk News:

HOUSES, APARTMENTS, SHOPS, &c.

TO BE DISPOSED OF, on or before Michaelmass next, a good COACHMAKER'S BUSINESS, in full Trade. Present hands nineteen years. Stock, &c., taken in Valuation. - Address, Robert Feaviour, Fressingfield.

In 1875 the Electoral Register showed him living at in Needham, Norfolk - living in Fressingfield owning freehold land near the Street in Needham, Norfolk. Robert appeared in the census in 1881 at Redenhall Road in Redenhall - 50, coach builder, living with wife Emma (41), children Mary Ellen (25, draper's assistant), Harriett (23, draper's assistant unemployed), Robert Lindsay (21, coach wheeler), Frederick George (18, coach painter), Margaret (6, scholar) and William C (1), and lodger Robert MURRAY (23, police constable). He died on 21 Oct 1887. On 27 Oct 1887 there was a newspaper report in the East Anglian Daily Times:

DEATHS.

FEAVIOUR. - On the 21st October, after a long and painful illness, Robert Feaviour, coachbuilder, of Harleston, aged 57 years.

Robert was buried on 27 Oct 1887 in Redenhall - aged 57. He had his estate probated on 10 Jan 1888 in Norwich, Norfolk - "FEAVIOUR Robert. 10 January [1888]. The Will of Robert Feaviour late of Redenhall-with-Harleston in the County of Norfolk Coachbuilder who died 21 October 1887 at Redenhall-with-Harleston was proved at Norwich by Robert Feaviour and Frederick Feaviour both of Redenhall-with-Harleston the Sons the Executors. Personal Estate £409 17s. 6d.".

Mary BORRETT was born c. 1828 in Stradbroke. She died c. 1868. She and Robert FEAVIOUR had the following children:

5. **Frederick George FEAVIOUR**, son of Robert FEAVIOUR and Mary BORRETT, was born c. 1863 in Stradbroke. He died c. 1949.
6. **Arthur FEAVIOUR**, son of Robert FEAVIOUR and Mary BORRETT, was born c. 1865 in Fressingfield, Suffolk. He died c. 1947.
7. **Margaret FEAVIOUR**, daughter of Robert FEAVIOUR and Emma WHITNEY, was born c. 1875. She died c. 1964.
