
Frederick William FELLINGHAM (1893-1956)

Frederick William Fellingham's connection to South Lopham is by residency.

Frederick William FELLINGHAM, son of William FELLINGHAM (c. 1854-c. 1933) and Sarah Ann KERRY (c. 1856-1932), was born on 7 December 1893 in Bressingham, Norfolk - mothers maiden name KERRY..^{1 2} He was baptised on 18 March 1894 in Bressingham - parfents William and Sarah³

The 1901 Census (held on 31 Mar 1901) shows Frederick at Lopham Road in Bressingham - 7, living with parents William (47, horseman on farm) and Sarah (45), and children William (15, yardman on farm), Allan (13, yardman on farm), Gertrude (10), Edith (5) and Lillie (1)⁴

At the time of the 1911 Census, Frederick was living at Near Crown Inn, Pooley Street in South Lopham, Norfolk - 17, miller's carter, living with parents William (56, miller's carter) and Sarah (54), and siblings Allen (23, yardman on farm) and Lily (11, scholar)⁵

Very little can be found about Frederick's military career. From the Medal Index Card there are two services, Norfolk Regiment, Private 31894, and the Army Service Corps, Private T4/058389.

In 1918 Frederick was on the Absent Voters List for in South Lopham at - No. 3997, home address Pooley Street, T4/058389 Dvr., 22nd L. of C. Supply Co. A.S.C. [Line of Command Supply Company, Army Service Corps]

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), he was living at Fen Street in Bressingham - 27, general farm labourer working for Arthur Musk of Redgrave, living with parents William (68, horseman and farm labourer working for Herbert Pearce of Valley Farm Bressingham) and Sarah (66, house duties), sisters Lily (21, shop assistant, out of work) and Gertrude (30, house duties), and brother-in-law Robert NOBLE (35, general farm labourer employed by Herbert Rose of Three Gate Farm in Bressingham)⁶

Frederick and **Rosetta MUSK** had marriage banns published on 17 December 1922 in South Lopham - other dates banns read were 24.12.1922 and 31.12.1922, both were single, Rosetta from Bressingham.⁷ He married her on 6 January 1923 in Bressingham.^{8 7 9}

In 1926 the Electoral Register showed him living at in South Lopham - No. 64, living at High Common, qualification by residency and occupation.

Frederick was recorded on the 1939 Register living at The Street in Rickingham, Suffolk - b. 07.12.1893, poultry dealer, living with wife Rose (b. 07.06.1896, unpaid domestic duties) and children Peggy M (b. 15.11.1824, drapery assistant) and Frederick (b. 20.09.1927, scholar)²

He died on 18 May 1956 in Rickingham¹⁰

Wives and known children:

Rosetta MUSK, daughter of George Henry MUSK (c. 1855-c. 1928) and Elizabeth COPPING (c. 1854-c. 1917), was born on 7 June 1895 in South Lopham.^{11 12} She was baptised on 27 August 1899 in South Lopham, the ceremony was conducted by Rev. J F BATEMAN, Rector - parents George Henry (mole catcher) and Elizabeth¹¹

Rosetta appeared in the 1901 Census at Pooley Street in South Lopham - 5, scholar, living with parents George (46, mole catcher) and Elizabeth (46), and siblings William (16, agricultural labourer), Sophia (11, scholar), Lilly (8, scholar) and George (1)

Rosetta appeared in the 1911 Census at Mere Street in Diss, Norfolk - 15, general domestic servant, living in the household of Ethel POWELL 41, of private menas)¹³

On 19 Jun 1921, (the 1921 Census), she was living at 15 Old Court Mansion in Kensington, London - 26, housemaid, living in the household of Ethel FANCOURT (59, no occupation)¹⁴

Rosetta was recorded on the 1939 Register living at The Street in Rickingham - b. 07.06.1896, unpaid domestic duties, living with husband Frederick W (b. 07.12.1893, poultry dealer) and children Peggy M (b. 15.11.1824, drapery assistant) and Frederick (b. 20.09.1927, scholar)>para>.² She died on 4 April 1979 in Rickingham - b. 07.06.1895, reg: Bury St. Edmunds Suffolk.^{12 15}

She and Frederick William FELLINGHAM had the following children:
