
Horace Frederick HUTSON (1889-1917)

Horace Frederick Hutson's connection to North Lopham is by birth and residence.

Horace Frederick HUTSON, son of Herbert Frederick HUTSON (c. 1863-c. 1947) and Ellen ARBON (c. 1862-c. 1913), was born on 27 June 1889 in North Lopham, Norfolk.^{1 2}

At the time of the 1891 Census, Horace was living at The Green in North Lopham - 1, living with parents Herbert Frederick (28, journeyman butcher) and Ellen (29), and sister Florence (5, scholar).³

Horace was baptised on 22 September 1892 in North Lopham.²

On 31 Mar 1901, (the 1901 Census), he was living at Black Horse Inn in North Lopham - 11, scholar, living with parents Herbert Frederick (39, innkeeper) and Ellen (40), and siblings Florence Ellen (15, living at home), Herbert Edward (8, scholar) and Sidney Arthur (6, scholar).⁴

Horace appeared in the 1911 Census at The Green in North Lopham - 21, butcher, living with parents Herbert Frederick (48, assistant butcher) and Ellen (49), and siblings Florence Ellen (25, barmaid), Herbert Edward (19, butcher) and Sidney Arthur (16, go out with butcher's cart).⁵

No service record has, as yet, been found for Horace, so all the information we have is the entry in the C.W.G.C. website.

Horace died on 3 May 1917 in France. The Commonwealth War Graves Commission grave registration entry for Horace was - HUTSON, Pte. Horace Frederick, 18814. 6th Bn. Northamptonshire Regt. 3rd May, 1917, Age 27. Son of Herbert Frederick Hutson, of Cavick Rd., Wymondham, Norfolk. Horace is commemorated at Arras Memorial - Bay 7, Course D, Stone 8.
