
Arthur Frederick NOLLETH (c. 1878-1924)

Arthur Frederick Nolleth's connection to North Lopham is by residence and death.

Arthur Frederick NOLLETH, son of Alfred NOLLETH (c. 1852-c. 1938) and Mary Amm WHITE (c. 1851-1889), was born circa 1878 in Kenninghall, Norfolk.¹

The 1881 Census (held on 3 Apr 1881) shows Arthur at Lopham Road in Kenninghall - 3, living with parents Alfred (29, agricultural labourer) and Mary A (29), and sister Edith E (5, scholar).²

At the time of the 1891 Census, Arthur was living at Lopham Road in Kenninghall - 13, farm labourer, living with father Alfred (widower, 38, farm labourer), grandmother Sophia (widow, 78, house keeper), and sisters Edith (15) and Louisa (6, scholar).³

On 31 Mar 1901, (the 1901 Census), he was living at 123 Grange Street in Burton upon Trent, Staffordshire - 22, maltsters labourer, boarding in the household of Frances BUXTON (widow, 53).⁴

Arthur and **Margaret GARNHAM** had marriage banns published on 2 July 1905 in South Lopham, Norfolk - spouse Margaret GARNHAM, both single and of this parish. Other dates banns read were 09.07.1905 and 16.07.1905.⁵ He married her on 27 July 1905 in South Lopham.⁶

In the 1911 Census (2 Apr 1911) he appeared at Rectory Road in South Lopham - 33, road maker, living with wife Margaret (32, housemaid), father-in-law David 37, farm labourer) and mother-in-law Ellen PRENTICE (67).⁷

Arthur joined at Norwich, Norfolk on 12 July 1916 - assigned to the Queen's Royal West Surrey Regiment, Private, Ser. No. 17872. From 18 August 1916 to 21 January 1919 he served with the British Expeditionary Force. At some point he transferred to the Royal Engineers, Driver, WR

22647. (There may have also been a transfer early to another section of The R.E., Serv. No. 247170.

Arthur was on the in 1918 Absent Voters List for South Lopham at Rectory Road - No. 4018, WR22647 Pnr., 313rd R.C. Co. R.E.

From 21 January 1919 to 26 February 1919 he served on home soil. He was Demobbed (Military) on 26 February 1919 and transferred to the Class "Z" Army Reserve. His home address given as Redgrave Road, South Lopham.

The 1921 Census (held on 19 Jun 1921) shows Arthur in South Lopham - 42y 2m, County Council roadman, living with wife Margaret (43y 2m) and father-in-law David PRENTICE (widow, 78y 3m, farm labourer).⁸

Arthur died on 5 June 1924 in South Lopham.⁹
